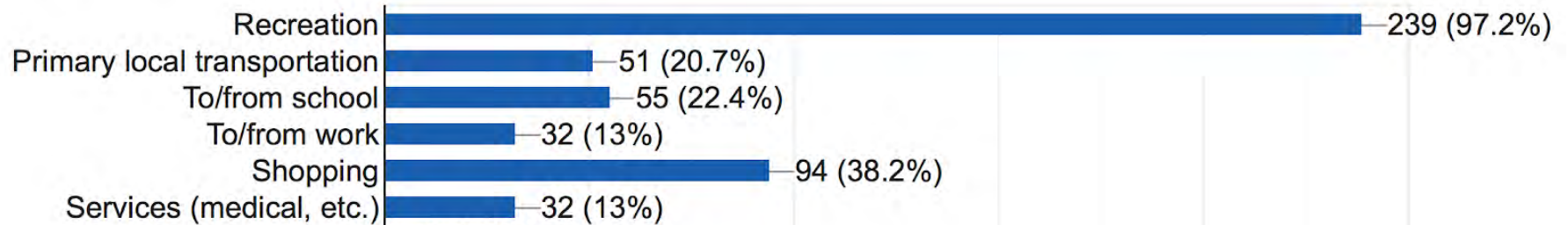

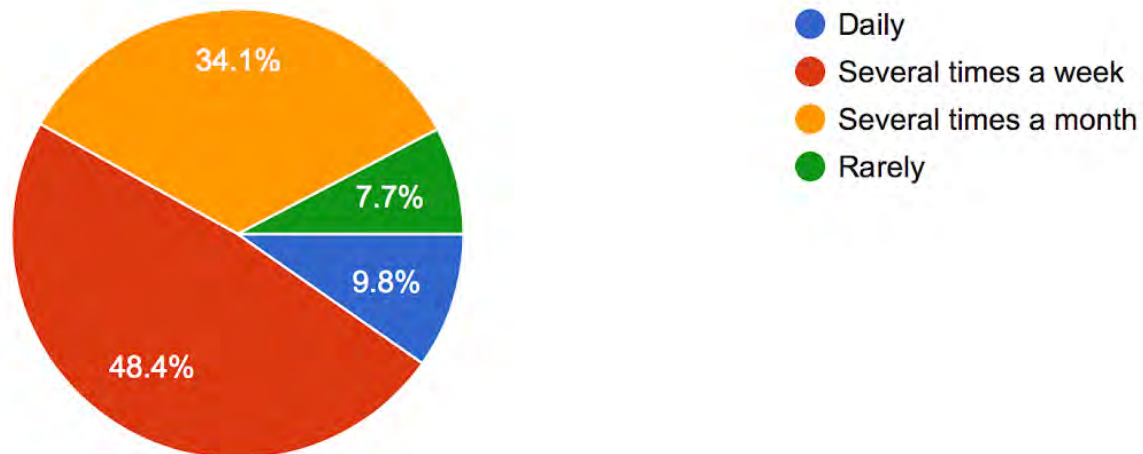
## Why do you cycle in Newburyport? (check all that apply)

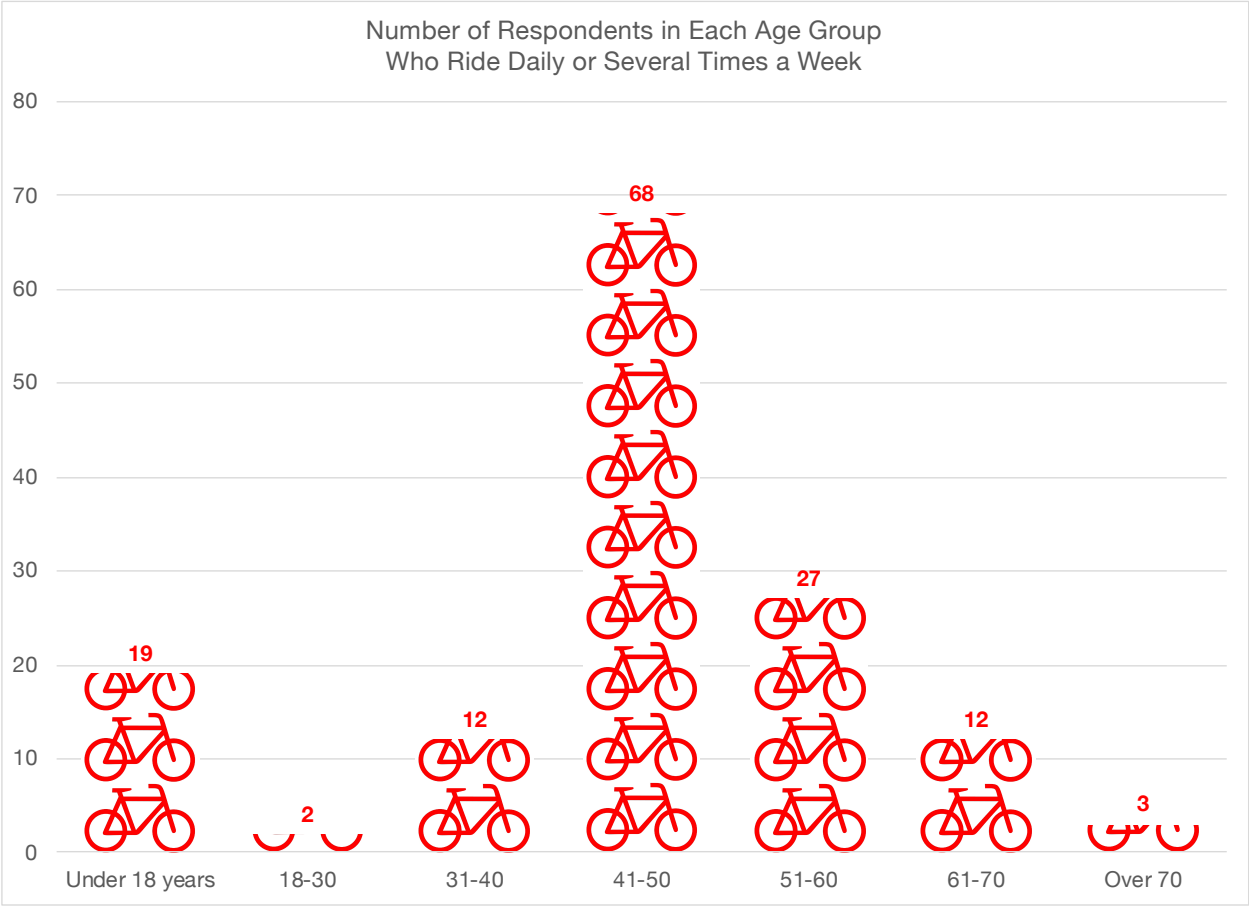


## How frequently do you cycle in Newburyport?

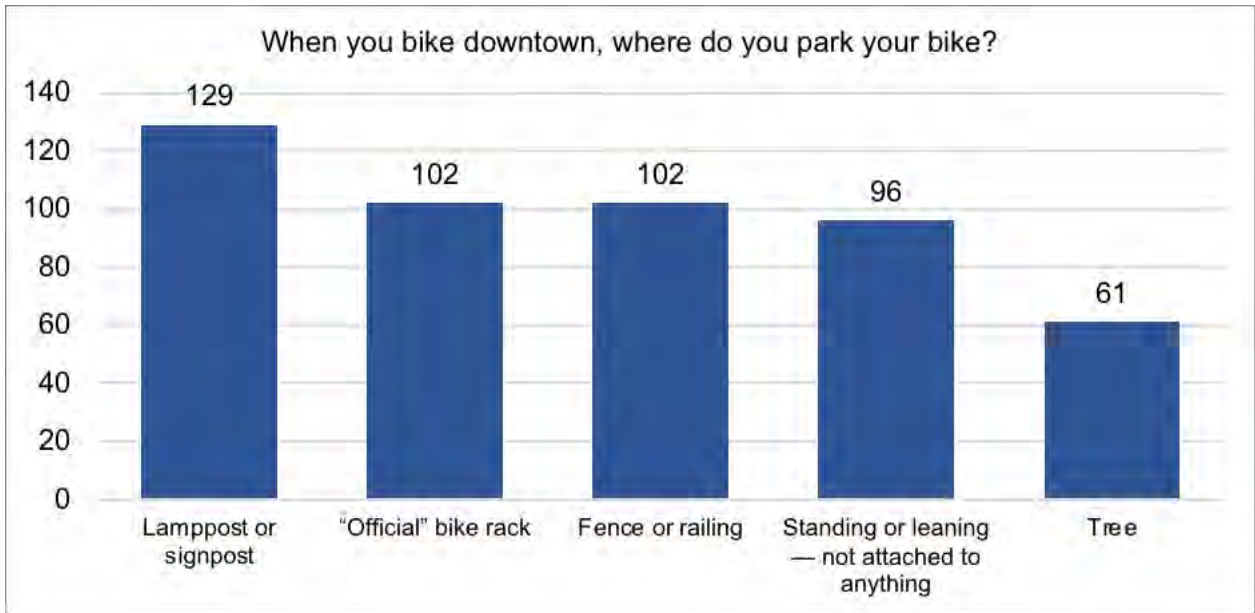


Number of Respondents in Each Age Group  
Who Ride Daily or Several Times a Week

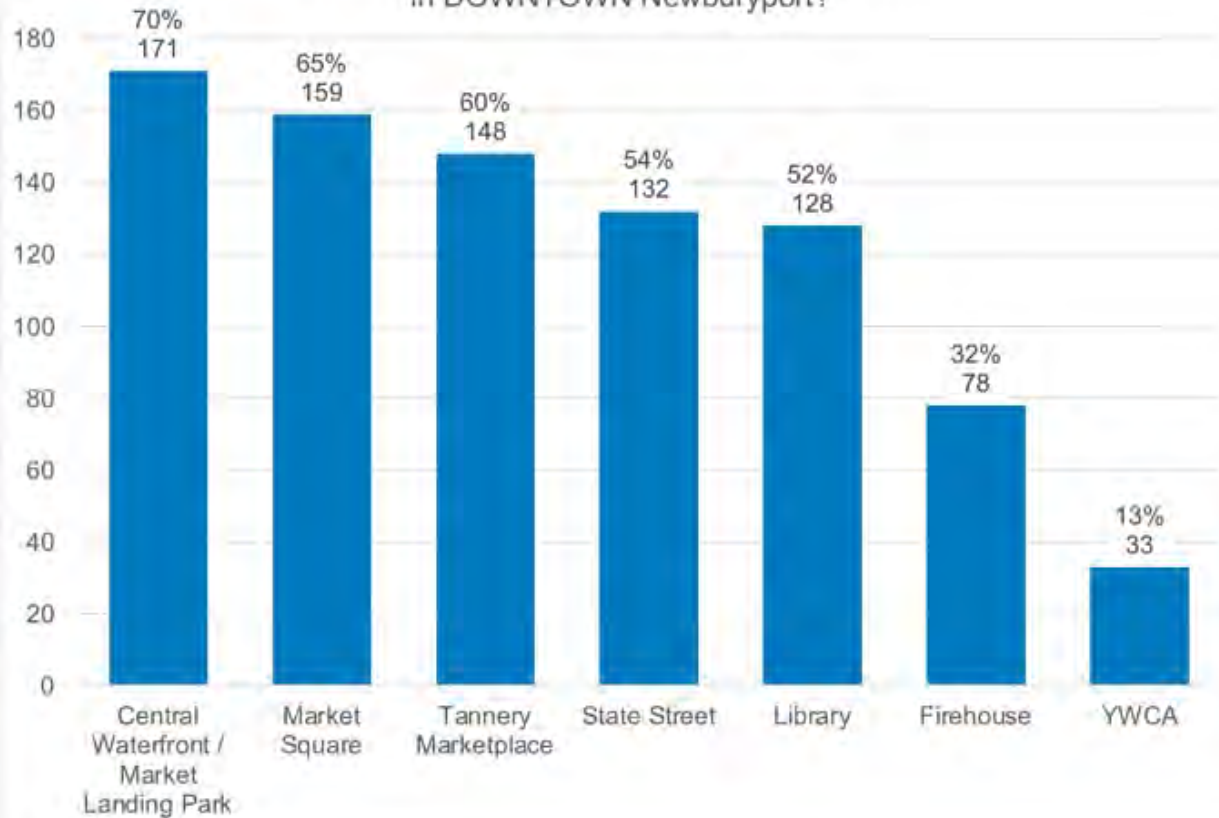


Percent of Respondents in Each Age Group  
Who Ride Daily or Several Times a Week





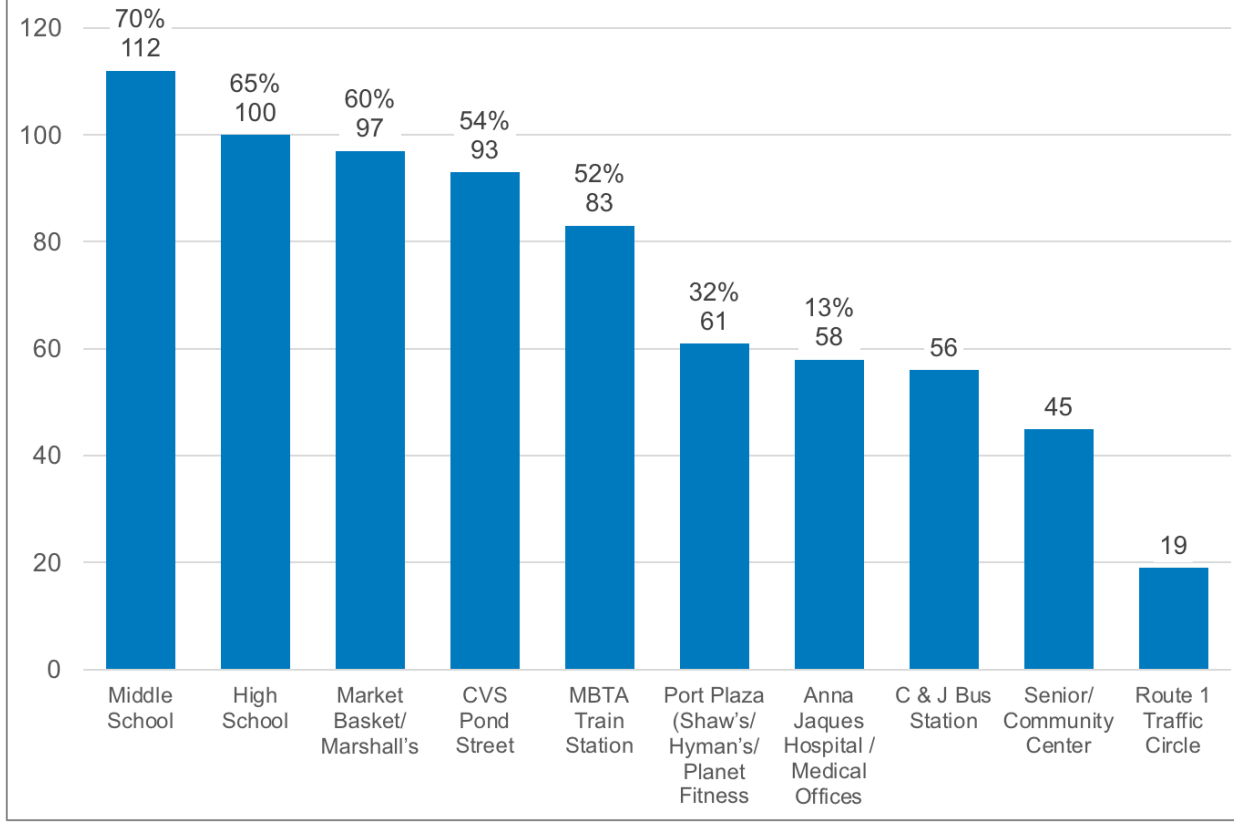
Where are additional bike racks most needed in DOWNTOWN Newburyport?

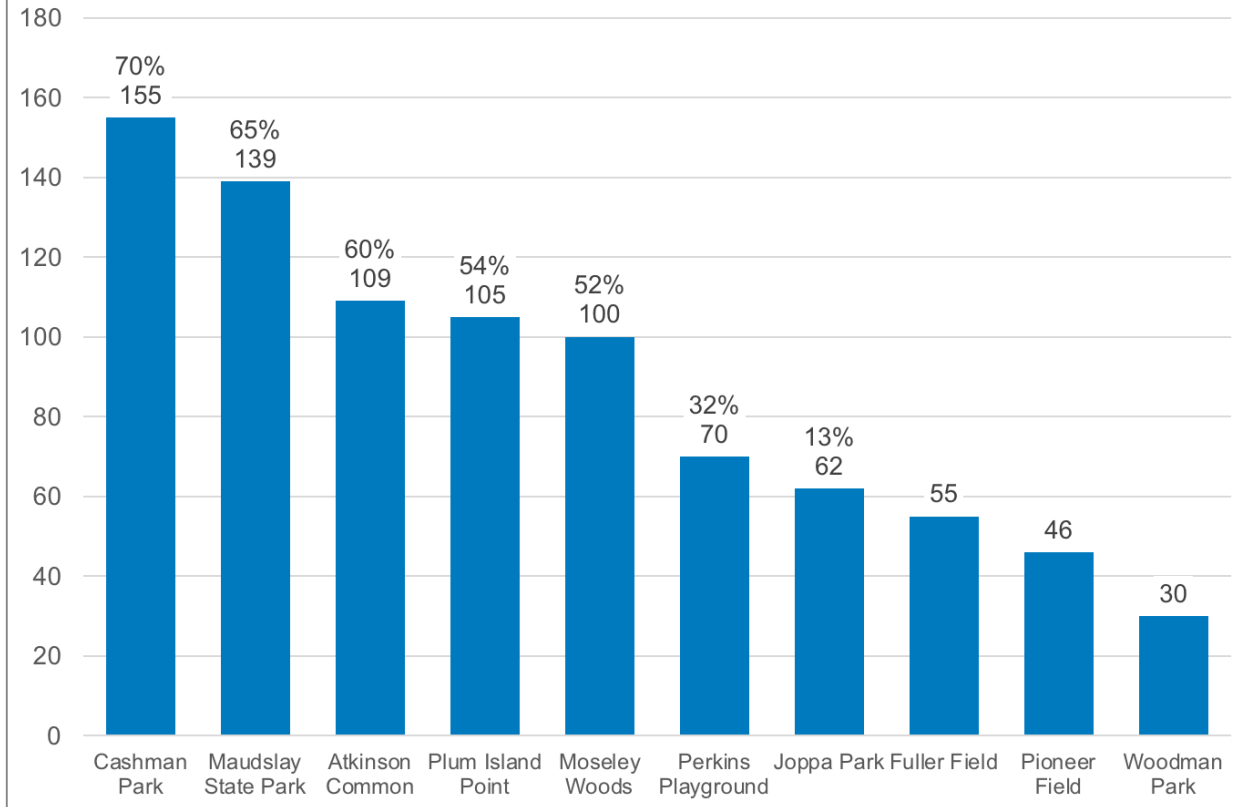




# Most Important – Outside Downtown

# Other Bike/Walk Issues

- Total responses – 127 (52% of all respondents)
- Bike Lanes – 54 responses
  - High Street Bike Lanes – 26
- General Safety – 40 responses
- Sidewalks – 19 responses

# Other Bike/Walk Issues

## High Street (35)

- Need for marked bike lanes, new curb cuts, islands
- Repaint / add better visibility to crosswalks

## Hale Street (12)

- Designated bike lanes
- Connect West End to downtown
- Extremely dangerous – cyclists and peds
- Need for sidewalk

## Merrimack Street (13)

- Need for bike lanes
- Crosswalks with flashing lights @ Kent & Merrimac

## Water Street (9)

- Need for bike lanes
